



# Swedish Leader Award 2002 - 2006



- ➤In total 54 projects were nominated
- ➤Only the 12 Leader Plus groups could nominate
- Leader criteria were used
- >Award ceremony at the yearly political week
- >Important when informing for the new programme period

# Rural Awards objectives



The main objectives for the Rural Awards are:

- ➤ Give inspiration and ideas to local actors
- ➤ Inform the general public about the results in the Rural Development Program

#### and also:

- Create a discussion on the implementation of the program
- ➤ Provide information to researchers about success factors



# Rural Awards categories



#### Categories for the Rural Awards are:

- Rural Project of the Year
- Rural Entrepreneur of the Year
- Leader Project of the Year

#### and for actions related to rural areas:

- Environmental initiative
- >Youth
- Integration of new citizens
- ➤ Gender equality



#### **Nomination Process**



- ➤21 county administrative boards nominate in all categories except for the Leader Award
- ≥63 Leader groups nominate for the Leader Award
- The nomination period is January 20:th to April 15:th

Criteria is based upon the objectives in the Swedish Rural Development Program



### Jury



- ➤21 county administrative boards can vote for one project in each category except for the Leader award
- ▶63 Leader groups vote for the Leader of the Year
- The jury is working May 1:st May 30:th

The Rural Network steering group makes the final decision



#### Common Criteria



- > Preserving and/or creating employment
- Creating conditions to increase the number of companies that develop, produce and/or commercialize new products and services
- >Increased tourism
- ➤ Village renewal and development
- Strengthening the local infrastructure, increased access to basic services and broadband
- Maintaining and upgrading the natural and cultural heritage



#### Common Criteria



#### Improvement of the environment and the landscape:

- Improving biodiversity
- Preserving the natural and cultural values
- Improving the water quality
- Tackling the Climate Change
- Promoting organic production
- Converting to renewable energy



# Extra positive if the project or activity:



- is based on collaboration between multiple stakeholders and different sectors
- >involves young people
- involves people with different ethnic backgrounds
- >contributes to gender equality



#### Leader criteria:



- >Local involvement
- ➤ Bottom-up approach
- >Innovative
- > Networking
- Transferable as inspiration or role model for others
- ➤ Based on collaboration between multiple stakeholders and different sectors
- Contributes to the implementation of the Leader strategy
- ➤ Has the potential to influence the structures and practices in their area



# Challenges for collection and dissemination of Good Practices



- ➤ How to secure good quality and good results in selected practices?
- ➤ How to define the needs of good practices among the target group?
- ➤ How to find efficient ways of dissemination?
- ➤ How to do research on methodology and success factors?


