The area is a multifaceted, large rural and mountain area with specific natural, social and economic features. Its development strategy, labelled as “a moving eco territory”, gives priority to improving quality of life via the consolidation of services to people, particularly enhancing accessibility and mobility. As an area of transition, our region benefits from various communications along the valleys, but the networks show unequal delivery points and many gaps. Such a situation generates mobility problems among the poorest mobile groups of the population.

The actions to be undertaken will aim at acting both on the mobility of people and the mobility and flexibility of services (gathering service delivering units, mobile services, one-stop-shops) and their ITC-based delivery.
