- Part I: Evaluation Plan in the RDP How to fulfil the minimum requirements?
 - Objectives / Purpose
 - The legal framework
 - Elements of the EP to be covered in the RDP
- Part II. From Plan to Practice.
 Recommendation on how to implement the Evaluation Plan
 - Following the 8 sections of the minimum requirement showing a) what needs to be covered, b) recommendations how it can be done
- Part III: Toolbox
 - Indicative template for EP as part of the RDP
 - Indicative template for ToR for evaluations
 - Indicative template for Annual Work Programme (not mandatory)
 - Generic time plan for conducting evaluation during programming period

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Feedback concerning... Overall structure



ExCo

- Short, but sufficient information on the development and implementation of the EP
- Focused only on minimum requirements for EP, for reporting, there is time for guidance

TWG

- Guidelines must take account of differences between MS → must remain open to different choices of MS
- EP is a base for evaluation during the programming period.
- DG Agri's specific approach should be reflected in guidance.

1. Objective & purpose



ExCo

- Highlight objectives and added value of evaluation
- Explain the utility of each element of the Evaluation Plan
- Summarize changes, compared to on going evaluation

TWG

Focus not only on the compulsory document to be delivered to EC but also show recommendations how evaluation can be effectively steered and implemented.

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2. Governance



ExCo

- Pros and Cons of different governance structures
- Role of stakeholders in the implementation of the EP, e.g. decisions on evaluation methods, data collections etc.
- Links between the EP, national policies and other operational programmes, Coordination of evaluation across EU funds

TWG

- Must not duplicate what is already written in the RDP concerning the set-up of monitoring and evaluation
- Coordination and communication among stakeholders should be highlighted
- Proportionality needs to be respected

3. Evaluation topics & activities European Evaluation Netwo

ExCo

Description of evaluation methods and their application in relation to:

- Economic, social and environmental analysis
- Measures with the biggest budget and implemented across programming periods;
- Complementary result indicators;
- o Specific evaluation themes;

Monitoring;

Interpretation of target indicators and the rationale behind;

Link Evaluation Plan and AIR

TWG

- Topics must remain open to upcoming evaluation needs (e.g. foresee ad-hoc evaluations)
- Evaluation tasks and activities should focus on results & impacts
- Evaluation Questions to be expected at the level of Focus Areas (+ horizontal issues)

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4. Data and information



ExCo

- Actors, structures and methods for data management and collection;
- Identification of data to be collected for evaluation and their sources;
- The use of case studies.

TWG

- Clarify what is needed to set up a targeted data management system?
- Focus on data-gaps and foreseen solutions to overcome them.
- Cost of data needs to be considered.

5. Timeline



ExCo

 Timing and time flexibility for evaluation activities carried out during the programming period;

TWG

- Need to define timing for the most important evaluation milestones, tasks, activities.
- Need to indicate what should be done in which time in order to observe the programme implementation and its achievements.

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6. LEADER



ExCo

LEADER is a specific evaluation topic,

Need to clarify:

- What shall be evaluated in relation to Leader? (added value and/or contribution of Leader to RD objectives)
- What is the role of selfevaluation?
- How can it be linked to evaluation of RDP?

7. Communication



ExCo

 Communication, dissemination, use of results for programme management.

TWG

Need to define:

- To whom and by whom should the evaluation result be communicated?
- What is the role of rural networks?
- What shall be communicated?
- What channels should be used?
- When and how often?

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8. Resources




ExCo

- Methods to estimate the budget for evaluation
- Methods how to evaluate resources
- Budget (indicative) for training, capacity development
- Outsourcing of evaluation

TWG

Need to clarify:

- How should we plan resources for evaluation tasks envisioned in the EP?
- What types of resources?
- What needs to be taken into consideration in planning resources?
- How can we fill resource gaps?
