



To stimulate knowledge exchange between research and stakeholders (end-users)




To value the input and knowledge of farmers and stakeholders




To widely disseminate relevant best practices and innovations








The cross-fertilisation approach

Multi-actors approach - added-values & difficulties?

- Better understanding of each others (e.g. farmers/advisors and scientists)
- Greater consideration of field inputs
- Greater efficiency to respond to needs

- A long process:
 - To trust each others
 - To perform the different tasks and to provide relevant responses
- Not everyone can take part
- Not everyone has the profile to take part
- Small groups with there own life






Multi-actors approach - behaviour changes?




Current OGs and equivalent included in SheepNet


