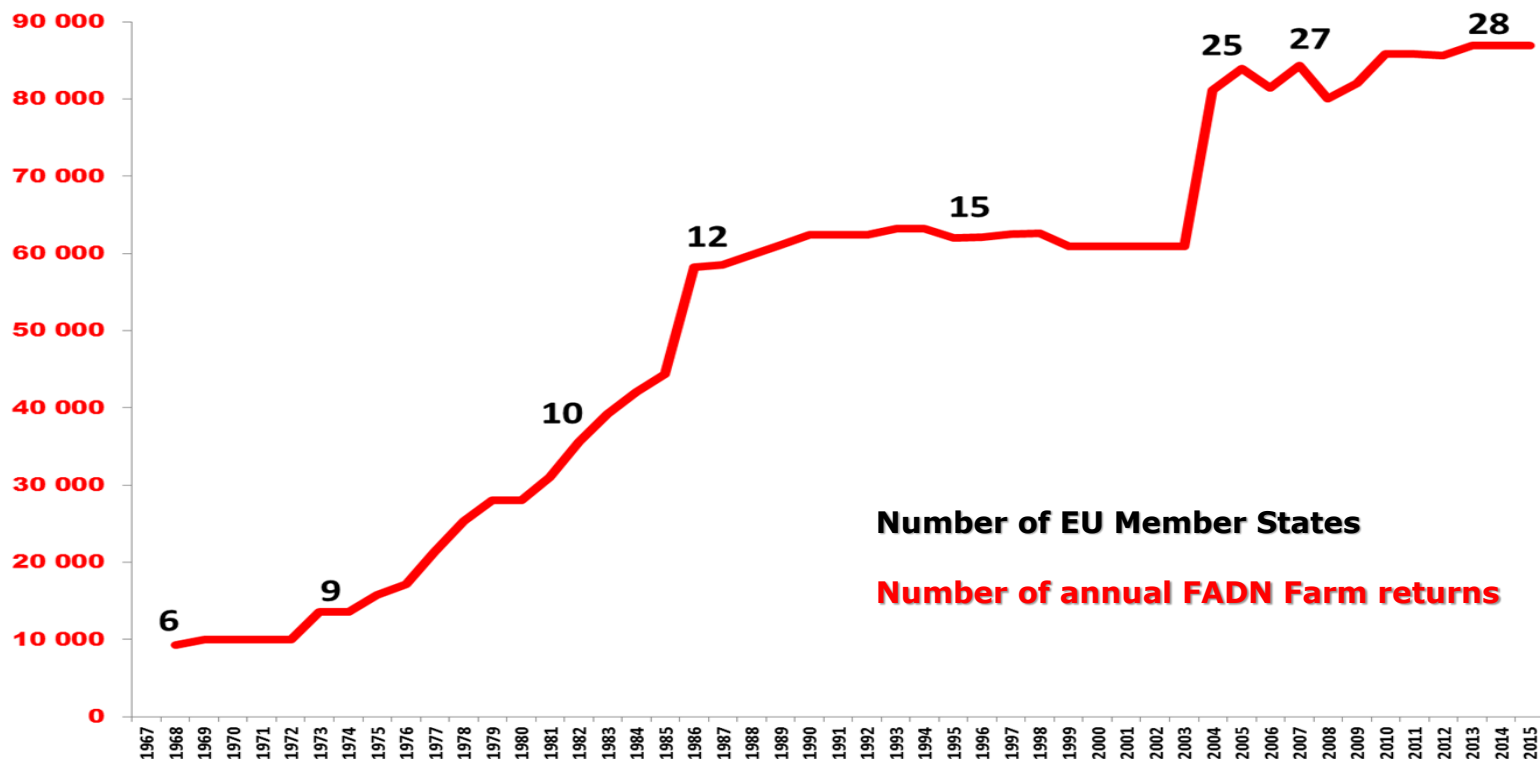


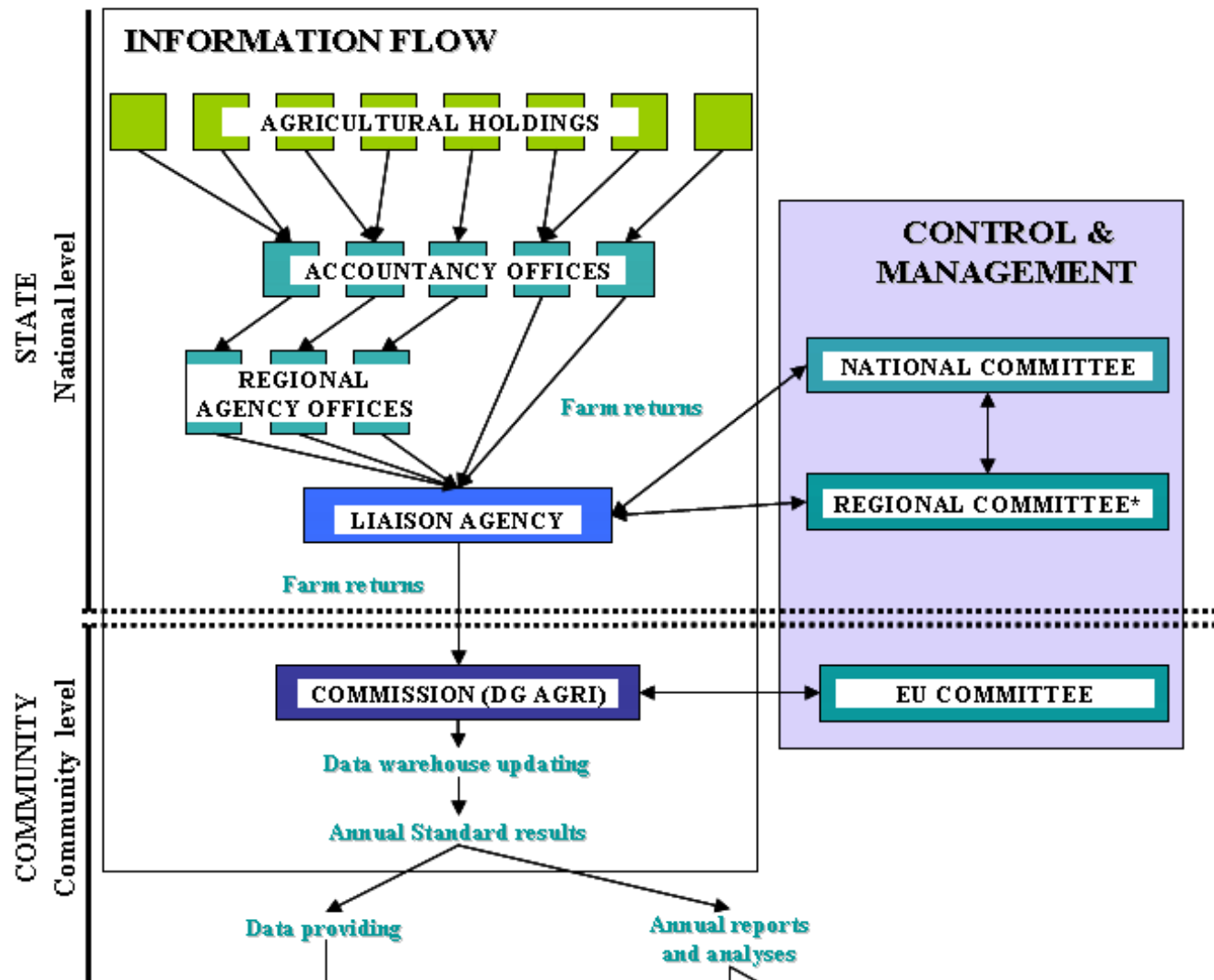
FADN data requests

The **Farm Accountancy Data Network** (FADN) is an instrument (survey) for evaluating the **income** of agricultural holdings and the **impacts** of the **Common Agricultural Policy** (CAP).

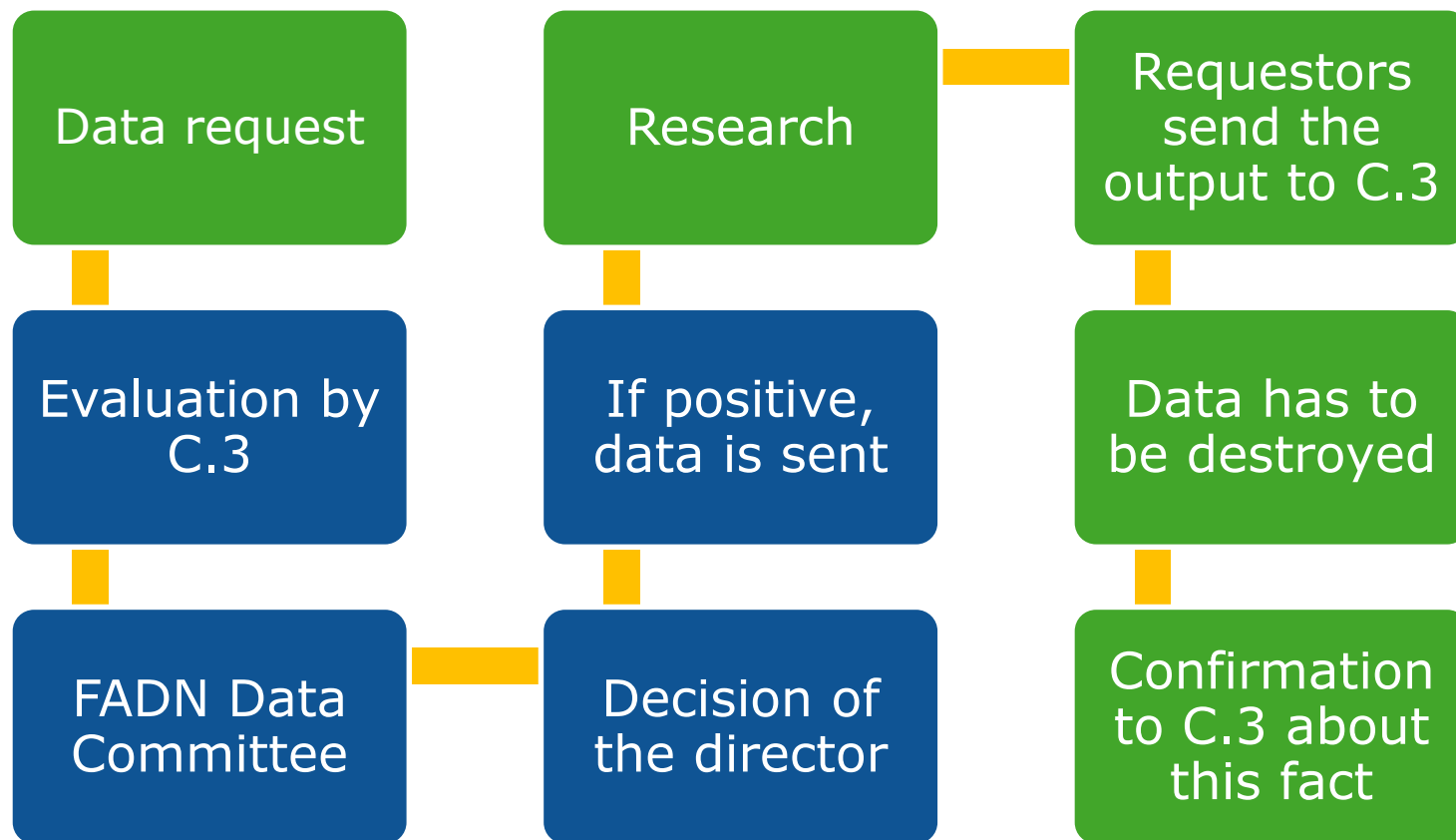
Established in **1965**.

FADN data access procedure in short



Three groups of IFD requestors

- The procedure distinguishes three types of request
 - Type 1 – EU Institutional project meaning projects of any EU institution or body
 - Type 2 – EU Contract project meaning a project under a contract/agreement of any other than DG AGRI Commission service or EU institution or body. Both types require an approval of the Head of Unit C.3 who can refer to the IFDC and Director
 - Type 3 – External request means any other than types 1 or 2 and includes among others independent researchers, research institutions or their consortia. All research subsidized by the EU (FPs e.g. Horizon 2020). Approval begins with assessment of DG AGRI C.3 then is presented to IFDC for evaluation and opinion. The Director of DG AGRI C Direction takes the decision.

FADN data access principles (1)

FADN data are anonymous.

No natural person can be identified directly or indirectly on the basis of FADN data, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data or to one or more factors specific to the economic identity of that natural person.

No access is given to data of sample farms recruited from very small populations (1-5) of similar farms in terms of their type and economic size class

Fictitious (encrypted) farm numbers are used instead of those reported by Member States

The time limit of access is that contained in the data access agreement, and it should be as short as possible

The only persons authorised to access the data are restricted to those listed in the agreement between DG AGRI C.3

The default limit of data variables to which access can be granted is 300 (three hundred) and the limit of data years is 10

FADN data access principles (2)

Data cannot be communicated to third parties

Not to make available in any form a result based on fewer than 15 observations (holdings)

Not to publish a result or set of results which could facilitate identification of a farm or farms

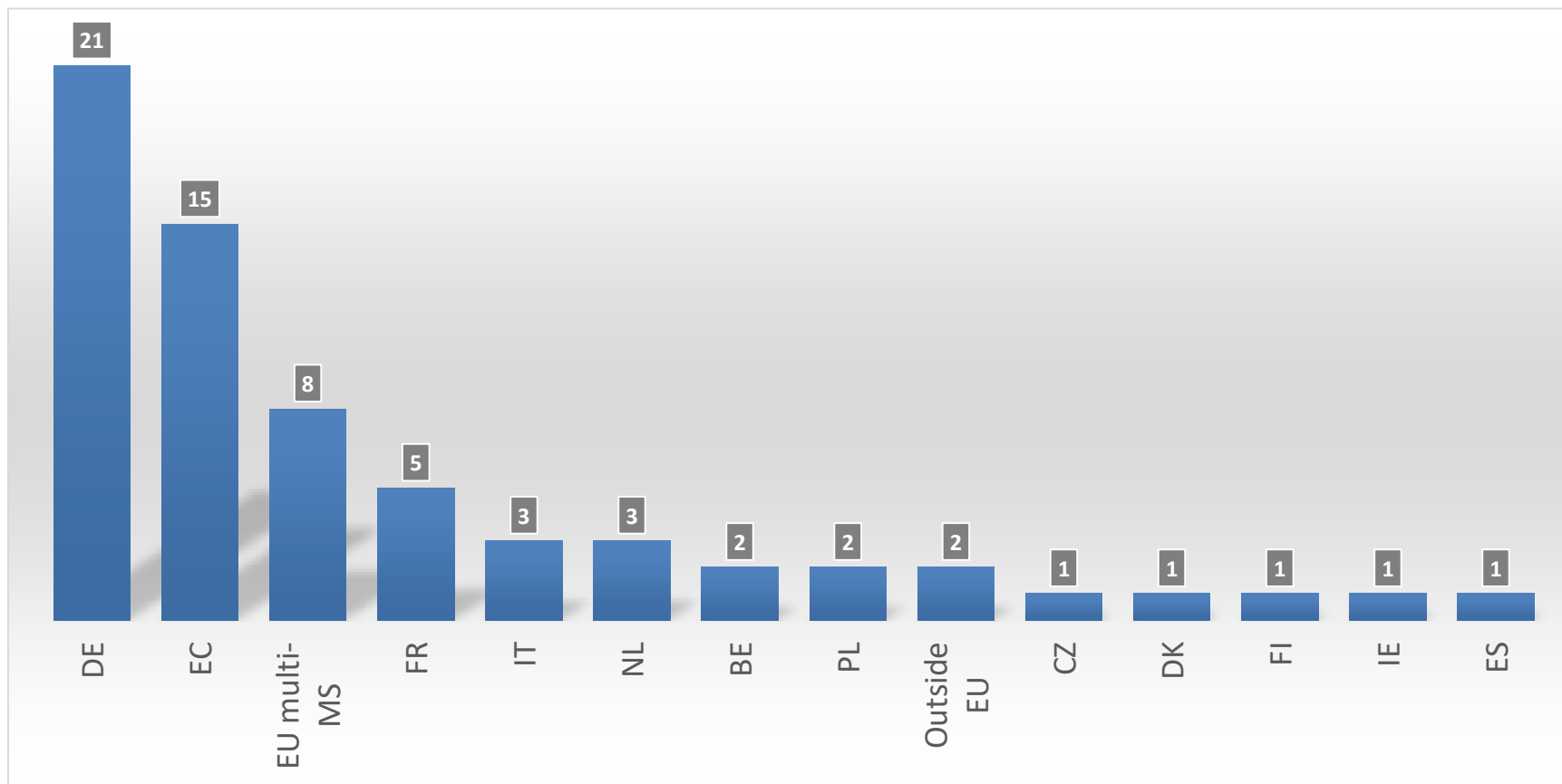
Not to combine the FADN data with other data or sources of information in a way that endanger the "non-personal" character of the FADN data

Ensure safe storage of the individual FADN data in the IT infrastructure not traceable, not accessible by searching Internet or similar networks, not accessible to any publically available commercial data storage providers, and exclude any other unauthorized access to the data

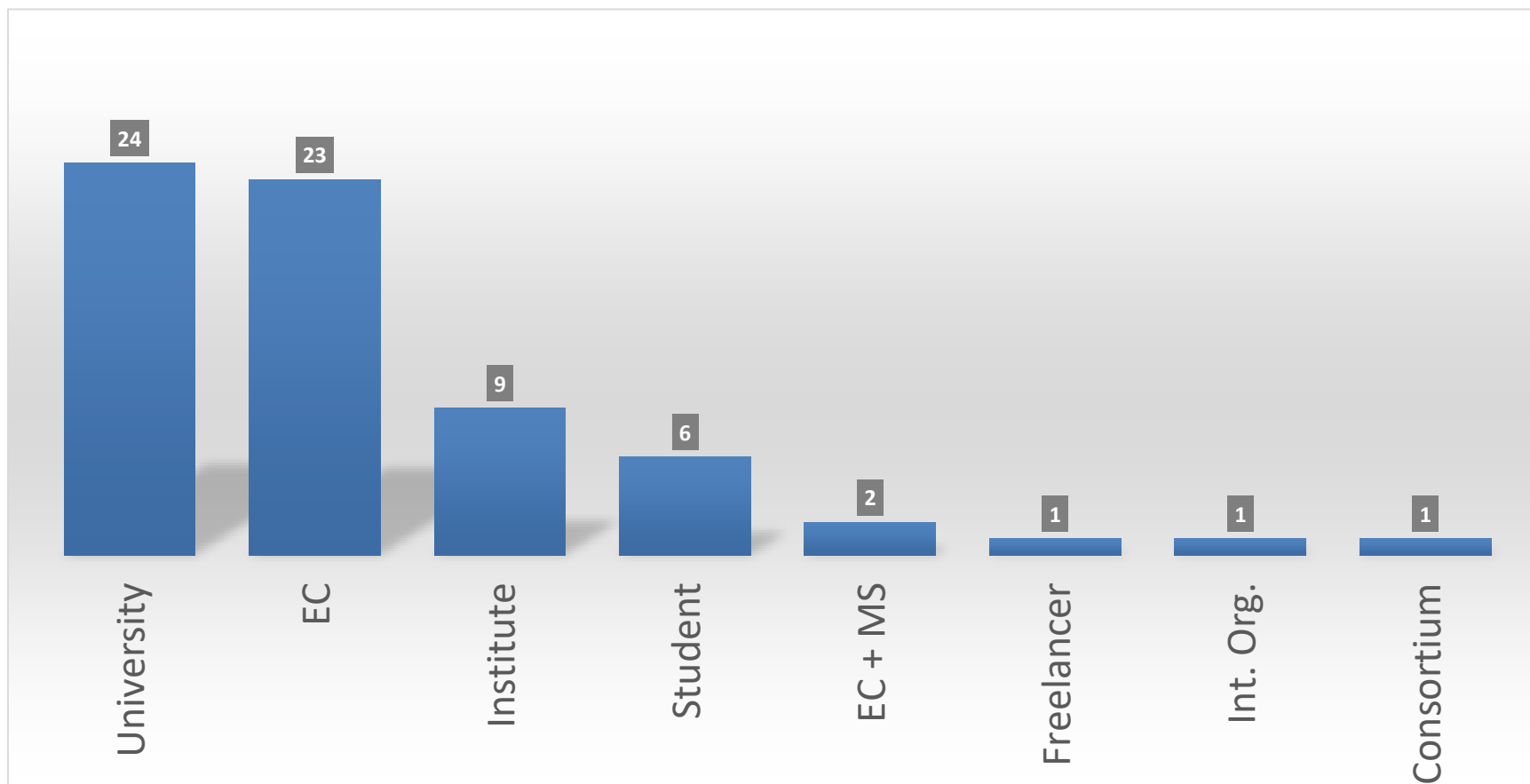
The Beneficiaries undertake to irrecoverably erase all the FADN individual data provided for the Project when the project is completed, abandoned or when the deadline for the access to data expires

The Beneficiaries agree to be controlled by the European Commission services at any time on matters, which relate to the use of the individual FADN data and commit to facilitate such controls.

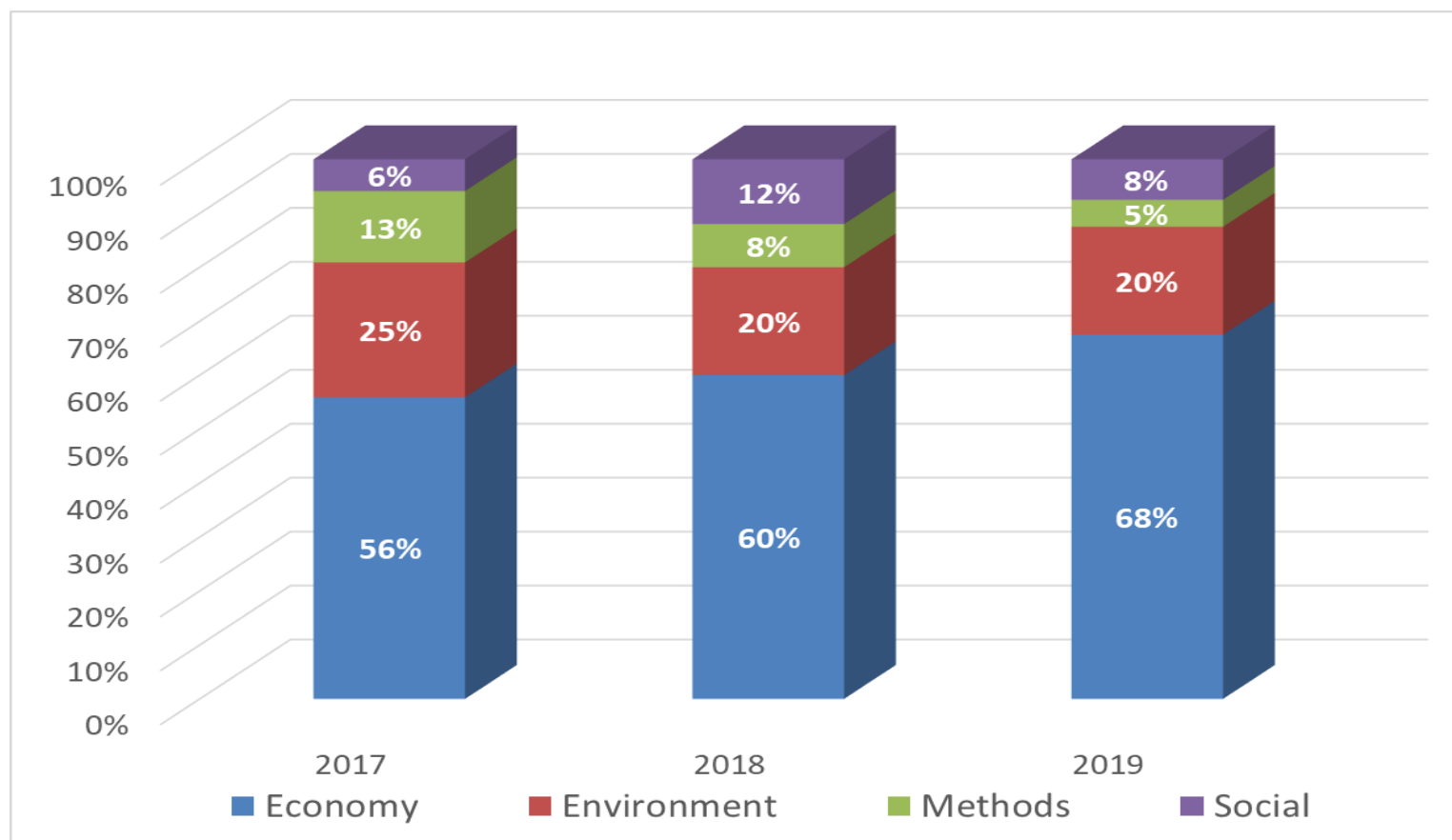
IFD requests by owners' country 2017-2019 (till 15 September)
