Legal basis for the Evaluation Plan

• Article 49(1) CPR: an evaluation plan shall be drawn up by the MA for each programme

• Article 49(2) CPR: MS shall ensure that appropriate evaluation capacity is available

• Article 9 RDR: The MS shall provide sufficient resources to address the identified needs (for evaluation)

• Article 83(1) RDR:COM shall establish minimum requirements for the Evaluation Plan





Minimum requirements

Evaluation Plan part of RDP Min reqs included in implementing act Changes via RDP modification

Plus: non-binding guidance to provide support for drafting, implementing and reporting





Purpose of the Evaluation Plan

Ensure sufficient and appropriate evaluation activity, in particular:

- Programme steering + AIR 2017
- Interim progress + AIR 2019
- Data availability
- EU level info (aggregation)





Proposed minimum requirements

8 sections:

- Objectives and purpose of the EP
- *Governance and coordination*
- Evaluation topics and activities

- Data and information
- Timeline
- LEADER
- Communication
- Resources





1. Objectives and Purpose

- Based on overall objectives
- MA may choose to augment





2. Governance and coordination

- Description of M&E system
- Identification of bodies and responsibilities
- Explain coordination mechanisms (RDP, ESIF)
- Procedures for quality control





3. Evaluation topics and activities

- Result and impact indicator values
- Assessment of net effects
- Thematic issues
- Cross-cutting issues
- NRN
- Technical Assistance
- Programme-specific elements
- Work needed to fill gaps (methodology, new aspects)





4. Data and information

- Data providers
- IT systems and interfaces
- Process for provision of required data
- Outline of methods and sources
- Data gaps and proposed solutions
- Quality control of data





5. Timeline

- Outline of timing needed to provide required info for the major milestones
 - AIR 2017
 - AIR 2019
 - Ex-post





6. LEADER

- Activities planned to support LAG level evaluation
- Approach to capture LDS outcomes for incorporating into RDP outcomes
- Evaluation of added-value of LEADER approach





7. Communication

- Describe communication strategy
- Identify target recipients and their needs
- Identify information channels
- *Mechanisms for follow-up on use of evaluation results*
