- R.31 - Growth and jobs in rural areas: New jobs in supported projects
- R.34 - Connecting rural Europe: Share of rural population benefitting from improved access to services and infrastructure through CAP support

 - o CMEF R.23 Percentage of rural population benefitting from improved services/infrastructures (focus area 6B)
 - o CMEF R.25 Percentage of rural population benefitting from new or improved services/infrastructures (Information and Communication Technology - ICT) (focus area 6C)

You are also welcome to present your current experiences on the CMEF indicator “R.22 Percentage of rural population covered by local development strategies”.

- Which difficulties do you currently meet, when compiling these indicators?
