Some limits of policies for mountain areas in Italy

- Discontinuous objectives and lack of a national strategy (except for special policy for Mezzogiorno in 80s);
- Limited financial budget (except for some areas interested by special efforts);
- Changing responsibilities among national, regional and local level;
- Lack of coordination between ordinary policies (e.g. education, health and transports) and development policies funded by EU;
- Complex mechanisms of governance.

Main challenges

- Cooperation between national and regional authorities and also within the single region among different sector administration;
- Adoption of the mountain issue as a priority in regional programmes;
- Set up a simple and effective mechanism of governance at local level and avoid overlapping of different initiatives
