PROGRAM

Day 1. 24 May. Meeting of the EU Member States' national rural networks and LAG's.

International conference will be held in the first part of the program. The second part is designed to share best practices and for the trips to introduce the successfully implemented national projects financed by the Lithuanian Rural Development Program 2007-2013.

Day 2. 25 May. International LAG's Fair. The aim of the fair is to strengthen and develop international collaboration, provide possibilities for sharing best practices, present projects and for the LAG's and the representatives of national rural networks to introduce themselves.

The participants of the fair will be given the space to represent their country, its uniqueness, projects implemented, culinary heritage and traditional crafts. The attendees will also have the possibility to interact with each other, establish cooperation, present local projects being implemented and discuss the ideas of current and future projects. We invite you to participate in the fair together with the representatives of the national rural networks.

The fair is organized by the member of the Lithuanian Rural Network Public Institution "Panemunės žiedai" in cooperation with the Lithuanian Rural Network Secretariat.

The fair will take place in one of the most beautiful places in Lithuania, near the Raudonė castle which dates back to the end of the sixteenth century. The participants will see "Panemunės žiedai" program for the 12th time organized theatrical festival of Raudonė castle. This is the Lithuanian cultural and culinary heritage project, attracting thousands of visitors from all over Lithuania annually in spring, the last Saturday of May.
