





# The « innovation dimension » of the future CAP network

## In the Commission proposal

<b>Mission</b>	<b>« A platform providing for more exchange of knowledge in order to capture the results and added value of the policy at European level, particularly the Horizon Europe policy »</b>
<b>Members</b>	<b>« Network of organisations and administrations, advisors, researchers and other innovation actors in the field of agriculture and rural development »</b>
<b>Objectives</b>	<b>« Fostering innovation and supporting the inclusion of all stakeholders in the knowledge-exchange and knowledge-building process »</b>
<b>Tasks</b>	<b>« Collection of information and facilitation of networking of funded structures and projects, such as [...] Operational Groups</b>
<b>Link with EIP Operational Groups</b>	<b>« Operational Groups shall disseminate their plans and the results of their projects, in particular through the CAP networks »</b>
<b>One of the three pillars of the AKIS</b>	<b>« Advisory services, research and CAP networks will work together within the framework of the AKIS »</b>


