# Monitoring and Evaluation of the new CAP

# Implementing Act (art. 120 and 129)

- To define the PMEF elements under art. 115 of the SPR with regards to monitoring and evaluation of the CAP
  - the ex post evaluation and all other evaluation activities of the CAP Strategic Plans (mainly evaluations carried out by MS during CAP plan implementation, following a common approach for all MS and the minimum content of the evaluation plans)
  - indicators' calculation methods;
  - regular reporting on monitoring and evaluation activities (evaluation plans)
  - data collection, storage and transmission;
- To define the data needs for monitoring and evaluation (DNM&E) to be provided by MSs according art. 129 of the SPR

### WP1: Calculation methods of indicators in Annex I

To provide MS calculation methods and/or data sources for each Output, Result and Context/Impact indicator in the Annex I of the SPR.

### WP2: Data needs for Monitoring and Evaluation

Information on implementation of the CAP plans needed for monitoring and evaluation

- Set of data for monitoring and evaluation
- Reporting system: timing and transmission system.
- Calculation methods (when needed)

The request for data is only for the relevant interventions to be monitored/evaluated and not a general request for all data.

# Work in progress



### WP3: Common approach for evaluations

Common elements for evaluations

- A set of Common Evaluation Questions for the CAP objectives and for the evaluation criteria (effectiveness, efficiency, etc.) to be used in evaluations
- Common judgment criteria and indicators to be used (TBC)
- Indicators to be used other than those of Annex I for the appropriate monitoring and evaluation of the CAP ONLY IF NEEDED!!
- Structure of the ex-post evaluation
- Guidelines to be developed



### **WP4: Evaluation plans**

To set-up the structure and minimum content of the evaluation plans

- Monitoring and Evaluation programme
- Capacity building activities
- Governance (coordination and governance arrangements of the bodies involved in monitoring and evaluating the CAP)
- Communication plan

and reporting framework for MS evaluations and evaluation plan implementation
