Within the cycle of meetings on the theme "The effective use of the evaluation results", the National Rural Network for Rural Development organises the 3<sup>rd</sup> event entitled "Toward effective communication of the evaluation results".

Effective communication is the main requirement to start the dialogue and debate on evaluation results and the way by which implementing them in the policy and its delivery. The communication is a powerful tool facilitating the action of the different mechanisms influencing the use (conceptual, instrumental, symbolic) of the evaluation's results. The aim of this event is to open the floor to administrations, evaluators, thematic experts and practitioners and discuss on questions like: what does effective communication mean? how communicate effectively the evaluation results? by which approaches, methods and tools? which evaluation results are to be communicated? why and when to communicate the evaluation results? who are the stakeholders and what is their role in communicating the evaluation results? which are the mechanism or elements influencing the effectiveness of the communication? what is the role of effective communication in spreading evaluation culture throughout administrations and evaluators?
