




Among the least rural countries in the OECD





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Predominantly Urban Regions


Intermediate Rural Regions

Predominantly Rural Regions






The role of agriculture is decreasing






The role of agriculture is decreasing



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Rural Italy performs above the OECD average




Employment share in manufacturing and services in rural regions (%)





Rural regions have a complex industrial mix





Rural areas with intensive agriculture

• RR IA - 1 632 municipalities, 22% population, 253 inhabitants/sq. km. 38% of agriculture's value added.

Intermediate rural areas


• IRR - 2 676 municipalities, 24% population, 32% of the national territory. Farming: -12% UAA, and -27% employment.

Rural areas with comprehensive development problems

• RR DP - 2 759 municipalities, 12% of Italy's population. 54 inhabitants/sq. km.




Analysing rural policy in Italy is complex

- The rural policy framework is influenced by agricultural and regional development policies.
- The EU framework is adapted at the regional level. Within this context:
 - There are <u>21 different rural development plans</u> (one per region) guided by the Ministry of Agriculture; AND
 - there are 3 different models of rural policy governance to guide implementation at the regional level.
- The Ministry of Economic Development also plays a role through the <u>Regional Policy</u>




The policy framework is complex





The rural policy ...

1. Maintains its sectoral focus





The rural policy ...

- 2. With a limited focus on place-based policies like LEADER initiatives
- 3. Still favours "capacity to spend" over efficient programming (action of regional governments)

4. ...and the ability of Regional Policy to focus on rural regions is constrained by its wider mandate



Recommendations

- Adopt a comprehensive rural development approach
- Promote institutional coordination, both at the central level and with regional administrations.
- Improve the current territorial classification
- Include territorial analysis in the policy setting.
- Capitalise on the Rural Network (Rete Rurale) to rural proof policies and give voice to rural instances

3. Give voice to rural communities (role of Rural Networks)





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
