Key objectives of data collection for LEADER

- To better understand and demonstrate the contribution of LEADER to CAP objectives;
- To better understand and demonstrate added value of LEADER approach in terms of improved social capital, better local governance and better quality of projects/results compared with non-LEADER delivery.
- MS will anyhow need to collect this information to calculate the relevant result indicators in the APR.
- Yet, keep the collection simple (infrequent and simply defined eg. number of operations) and collect information already available in the system (no request for new additional data)
