# DG AGRI Evaluation Plan 2016-2020

The proposed planning of the future evaluations is based on the following elements:

- the 6-year evaluation cycle foreseen in Article 18(3)(b) of Regulation (EU) No 1268/2012;
- the Better Regulation Guidelines;
- requirements for evaluation laid down in specific legislation;
- Commission commitments to other institutions;
- Needs of DG AGRI units.





# Minimum standards for evaluations following the better regulation guidelines:

- Evaluation roadmap published 4 weeks for feedback
- Questions on:
  - Effectiveness
  - Efficiency
  - Relevance
  - Coherence
  - EU value added
- 12 week, open, internet-based public consultation as part of evaluation
- Preparation of a staff working document next to the report of the contractor





#### **CAP** evaluations

#### Reporting on the performance of EU policies:

- Article 110 of Regulation (EU) No 1306/2013;
- First results on the performance reported no later than 31 December 2018;
- Second report including an assessment of the performance of the CAP shall be presented by 31 December 2021.


#### **Evaluation of the CAP in relation to its general objectives:**

- Use of framework contracts (FC) to reduce time needed by procurement procedure;
- One framework contract for each general objective of the CAP, one for synthesis and cross-thematic issues
- These framework contracts are preceded by a mapping and first analysis of CAP implementation currently ongoing
