Submission of AIRs

- Submission by 30 June
- Covers previous calendar year
- 1st report due 2016
- Submission each year up to 2024
- 2017 and 2019: enhanced AIRs





The AIR and the Evaluation Plan

- Evaluation Plan (EP) is a tool for planning evaluation activities throughout the programming period.
- Summary of activities undertaken to be included in the AIR.





Content of the AIR in relation to reporting on evaluation

- Three sections:
 - "Standard" AIR every year
 - Enhanced AIR 2017
 - Enhanced AIR 2019





Content of "standard" AIR (reporting on evaluation)

- 1. EP modifications
- 2. Evaluation activities undertaken*
- 3. Activities related to provision and management of data*
- 4. List of completed evaluations*
- 5. Summary of completed evaluations
- 6. Communication activities*
- 7. Follow-up of evaluation results*





Additional elements for 2017 AIR

- 1. Contribution of RDP to secondary focus areas, including quantification
- 2. Programme achievements, (assessment of the complementary result indicators; relevant evaluation questions; quantification).





Additional elements for 2019 AIR

- 1. Contribution of RDP to secondary focus areas, including quantification
- 2. Programme achievements, (assessment of the complementary result indicators; relevant evaluation questions; quantification).
- 3. Interim impact of the RDP: contribution to programme and EU strategy and objectives, (assessment of the programme's net contribution to changes in CAP impact indicator values, and relevant evaluation questions).





Considerations for reporting

• Reporting should be linked to the Evaluation Plan.

• Describe difficulties encountered, together with solutions adopted or proposed.
