Submission of AIRs

- *Submission by 30 June*
- *Covers previous calendar year*
- *1st report due 2016*
- *Submission each year up to 2024*
- *2017 and 2019: enhanced AIRs*



The AIR and the Evaluation Plan

- *Evaluation Plan (EP) is a tool for planning evaluation activities throughout the programming period.*
- *Summary of activities undertaken to be included in the AIR.*

Content of the AIR in relation to reporting on evaluation

- *Three sections:*
 - **“Standard” AIR – every year**
 - **Enhanced AIR 2017**
 - **Enhanced AIR 2019**

Content of "standard" AIR (reporting on evaluation)

1. *EP modifications*
2. *Evaluation activities undertaken**
3. *Activities related to provision and management of data**
4. *List of completed evaluations**
5. *Summary of completed evaluations*
6. *Communication activities**
7. *Follow-up of evaluation results**



Additional elements for 2017 AIR

- 1. Contribution of RDP to secondary focus areas, including quantification*
- 2. Programme achievements, (assessment of the complementary result indicators; relevant evaluation questions; quantification).*



Additional elements for 2019 AIR

- 1. Contribution of RDP to secondary focus areas, including quantification*
- 2. Programme achievements, (assessment of the complementary result indicators; relevant evaluation questions; quantification).*
- 3. Interim impact of the RDP: contribution to programme and EU strategy and objectives, (assessment of the programme's net contribution to changes in CAP impact indicator values, and relevant evaluation questions).*

Considerations for reporting

- *Reporting should be linked to the Evaluation Plan.*
- *Describe difficulties encountered, together with solutions adopted or proposed.*
