# (1) Planning





### LEADER – Planning results: Drafting and Approval of CAP SP

(1) Choose a result indicator that...

... is linked to specific objective h

...can incorporate contributions from LEADER

(2) Attribute this RI to the LEADER intervention(s) in the CAP SP

(3) When planning milestones and targets for this RI...

...take the expected contributions from LEADER into account



### LEADER – Planning results: After selection of LDS

Amend the CAP SP and...

...based on the design of the LDS  $\ _{\circ}$ 

(1) Attribute other RI where LEADER is expected to make a contribution

(2) Adjust targets and milestones for those RI to take the expected contributions from LEADER into account

Operations contributing to environmental sustainability, etc. (R23a)

## **LEADER – Planning outputs and financial allocations – financial table:**

- Covers the whole period
- Split per Financial Year (FY)
- Each output planned entirely and only once for the FY where 1st payment to be made (not advances)
- Estimated payments for FY (EAFRD + national co-financing)
- Split in 2 interventions recommended (preparation LDS / implementation LDS)
- Two sub-sets of 0.27: different eligibility, different unit amounts
- Average unit amount: estimate of
  - average payment for preparation of LDS
  - average budget of a LDS

## LEADER- reporting on outputs under performance clearance

- Output reported in given FY when payment made
  - For clearance: calculated proportionally to payment made (n°LDS which got paid in a year x % of total financial allocation they received)
  - For monitoring purposes: in full (n°LDS supported in a year)
- Separate reporting per intervention\*:
  N° of LDS prepared
  N° of LDS implemented

\* General rule: per unit amount, but here, 1 intervention <>>> 1 unit amount

## **LEADER** implementation – reporting on output indicators, deviation of unit amount

### Monitoring FY2: O. 27 LDS implemented = 60

Example:

- 60 LDS get paid in that particular FY (instead of 100) Tot. budget allocated = 1000 (15% paid) Output = 15%\*60 LDS =9
- Average unit amount: 16,6>10 (planned)
- Deviation: Details to be provided







## LEADER – reporting under performance clearance

- Deviations from annual planned outputs (annual number of strategies) is not an issue for performance clearance
- Deviations from the indicative financial allocation is not an issue
- Deviation from the planned average unit amount can be explained under performance clearance
