

Guideline for poster presentation

Posters must be on A0 size paper (ca. 85 x 120 cm).

The poster should contain the title of the project (at least 2 inches/5 cm high) as well as a list of all authors and affiliations. Use this information as a headline in your work.

Text should include a brief explanation of the problem and of the innovative solutions. The focus must be on the approach used to foster the co-innovation process and, possibly, on the role of Extension and Education. Ensure the flow of your poster is logical.

Provide a clear "take-home message", which highlights the main results of the co-innovation process described in your poster.

Your poster should be able to be read at distance; therefore, you are kindly recommended to use an appropriate text size. Minimum recommended text sizes are: 85pt font for the main title, 36pt for subheadings, 24pt for body text, and 18pt for captions. Avoid colour combinations which are difficult to read. Make use of pictures.

Approved abstract authors can hang up their posters at the ESEE 2019 conference venue, from Tuesday, 18 June 2019, between 10:00 and 15:00.

The organisers will provide suitable fixing materials, and onsite assistance will be available to help you to display your poster.

It is not possible to print posters on-site!

Please be sure to register to the conference to present your poster. At least one author must be present during the poster viewing to explain your work and answer questions.
