





TECHNICAL GROUP ON MONITORING AND EVALUATION





The aim of the technical group is to **encourage and foster interactions and discussions between stakeholders on monitoring and evaluation topics** through regular meetings. This group was formed because this is the first programming period where these activities have been decentralised to the 27 regional Managing Authorities (MAs). This group meets 2-3 times a year and is composed of roughly 27 representatives (all the regional MAs or their representatives). The main outputs of this group are to:

- create a global understanding of different practices and procedures in the regions;
- prepare and exchange best practices;
- identify common questions for the Evaluation Helpdesk;
- identify common problems and concerns, in order to improve the evaluation process.

The conclusions of this group are regularly shared in each governance committee where a specific point is provided for evaluation.





Steps of Implementation

- 1. The NRN conducted a survey of the needs of MAs in the MA group (COMOP) and in the regular meeting of the RRR (regional networks).
- 2. Specific actions were proposed in the general assembly and a thematic group was launched.
- 3. A short video will be produced on evaluation along with an article in the next national publication. A study on indicators and methodologies will also be published.



Recommendations

- Keep an open dialogue with evaluation stakeholders to identify new challenges and find solutions for these challenges.
- Begin these types of thematic groups earlier on in the programming period, in order to provide better support and effect greater change.
- It is important to have very concrete topics for discussions, in order to best find solutions.
