


Indicators for monitoring and evaluation of the CAP post 2013



Monitoring and evaluation post 2013

- *Monitoring and evaluation system post* 2013 covers whole CAP
- Pillar II CMEF revised and brought in line with overall system





*CSF: Common Strategic Framework including the EFRD, ESF, CF, EAFRD and EMFF




Purpose of monitoring and evaluation

- Evaluation is requirement for any policy using EU budget
- *Monitoring and evaluation is opportunity to:*
 - Assess performance of CAP (what does the policy actually deliver?)
 - Enhance CAP's acceptance and credibility
 - *Receive input for policy steering*



Discussions with Member States

- Member States concerned about burden of system
- Commission develops system in close cooperation with Member States
- Process for post-2013 started with Stakeholder conference in September 2011, latest discussion 14-15 March





Main concerns of Member States in 14-15 March meeting

- high number of indicators
- burden of data collection
- need to take account of available data sources
- lack of feasibility and relevance of some of indicators





Adjustments to indicator proposals

- List updated from perspective of consistency, data availability, simplicity and suitability
- Indicators based as far as possible on existing data sources and definitions
- For impact indicators, data collection and use mostly at Member State/EU level through established channels
- For Pillar II result indicators, several deleted and others modified/clarified
