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Monitoring the implementation of FAS



What is relevent to monitor?

✓ the financial resources

✓ the process of delivery (financial and procedural data)

✓ the <u>human resources</u> involved: administrators, advisors and holders

✓ the <u>tipologies of services</u> delivered

✓ the <u>fields of services</u> delivered

✓ the <u>structures</u>: advisors' and holders'

How gather the data and information needed?

✓ Interviews, questionnaire, checklist, case-studies ...

✓ Monitoring systems: specific for the FAS or integrated to other fields of knowledge systems?

The Regulatory framework: is it adequate?

- » The relevance of the FAS for addressing problems, needs and issues of the agricultural and forest sector
- » The flexibility and subsidiary of MSs in addressing the specific needs
- » The accessibility of the system for a wider range of farmers

□ The delivery mechanisms: are they supportive?

- » Administrative: The procedures for applying
- » Quality of the advise: criteria of selection, competences and trustiness of the advisories
- » Methods for delivering advice
- » Fields of advice: tailoring the advice to demand-driven and consumer-driven at MS/local level.
- » Approach: participative or top-down?

□ The efficiency: is it worth?

- » Cost-benefits analysis
- » Synergies with other measures

□ The effectiveness: which effects are expected?

- » Increase of awareness: Improvements of environmental-friendly behaviors
- » Improvements of environmental performance and contribution to climate-change
- » Improvements of competitiveness
- » Development of human potential and innovation

□ The contribution to the wider knowledge system

- « The integration of FAS into the KS: the effects in the value chain
- « The value added to the KS
- « The pertinence for the different fields of advisory and of the development of human potential in agriculture and forest sector

□ The contribution of the on-going and mid-term evaluations of RDPs

- » In view of revising the delivery mechanisms
- » Analyze and compare the different ways to perform in efficiency (benchmarking)
- » Revise the legal framework

- On-desk :

- In the field:
 - Interviews, questionnaire,
 - Case-studies
 - Farmer surveys
- Counterfactual analisys

Definition and use of indicators

- Going beyond the CMEF: define additional indicators addressing the specific needs for measuring the effects of the FAS
- Qualitative indicators to be used as complementary to Quantitative indicators
- Setting up a set of indicators for benchmarking utility and aggregation at European level
