Intervention logic

Relationships between

- Needs (SWOT)
- Objectives (EU2020, CSF, CAP)
- Priorities (6 RD priorities)
- Measures (23 + LEADER approach)



Intervention logic

Related indicators

- Needs (SWOT) - context
- Objectives – impact (overall level)
- Priorities – result (target)
- Measures - output



Context indicators

- Description of initial situation
- Economic, environmental, social
- Used to develop SWOT
- Assessed in ex-ante
- Values updated at points within programming cycle



Output indicators

- Linked to measures
- Simple physical counting
- Captured from application forms
 - (? subsequent verification)
- Including financial expenditure
 - (could be referred to as input)
- Reported quarterly for selected and completed operations



Result indicators

- Linked to priorities/focus areas
- Capture direct effects of interventions
- Use information from application forms, standard coefficients/formulae
- Use established indicators/methods where possible
- Most estimated at project selection
- Verification post-project completion (sample basis)



Impact indicators

- Overall CAP level
- Linked to wider objectives of RDPs
- Assessed as part of evaluations, not regular monitoring
- Demonstrate wider benefits
- Often require counterfactuals
- May use data such as FADN, Eurostat, environmental surveys



Target indicators

- Sub-set of the indicator hierarchy
- Related to priority focus areas
- Principally drawn from result indicators
- Must be simple and easily monitored
- Targets set for each indicator ex-ante at programme level
- Reported quarterly for selected and completed operations
