Introduction

- Draft technical structure of the Annual Implementation Report (AIR) for information encoding. It does not correspond to final AIR layout which will be, notably, completed with overview report tables
- It does not include financial reports and monitoring indicator tables and reports
- The purpose is to clarify the structure of the AIR



Section 1: Implementation of the programme

Key information on implementation of the programme and its priorities

- · In principle, financial data reports based on available information
- Monitoring indicator reports automatically generated (see examples in annex)
- Monitoring tables for data submission (see template from September RDC)
- Text Box: Key information on RDP implementation
- Text box: (from 2017): key information on achievements towards the milestones set in the performance framework

Section 7: Assessment information & progress towards achieving RDP objectives (2)

- One single template
- To be replicated for each of the 21 common evaluation questions to be answered in the AIR 2017 and for any programme-specific evaluation question
- Divided into three parts:
 - Description of the system for answering the evaluation question (indicators, data and methods used, etc.) (text box)
 - Calculated value of the indicator (common, additional or programme-specific), including any comments (text box and table)
 - Answer to the evaluation question (text box)



Bi-Annual Indicator Data Provision (BAIDP)

Article 66 1(b) of Regulation 1305/2013 (committed expenditure/Table A): submission by 31 January and 31 October (+ WD on monitoring, page 3)

If first Submission of BAIDP (October 2015), it should cover expenditure committed from beginning 2014 until 31 August 2015

Currently, for RDPs approved by end of August (end limit of the reporting period) a significant share is still missing
