




Mutual exchange and learning


Case of Wallonia:

Use of stakeholder contacts in evaluation

- Access of NRNs to wide range of stakeholders
- Channel it into RDP evaluation & programming
- Especially useful for ex-ante evaluation
 & RDP design/adjustment
