FG20 WILL CONCENTRATE ON...

• Framework :

- **Increasing demand** of forest biomass for energy generation, wood fibres, chemicals, ...
- Major challenges in mobilising forest biomass
 - Sustainability
 - Competitiveness of the forest-based industries
 - Efficiency and economic viability
 - Fragmentation, organisation, motivation of forest owners
- Need of economic, environmental and social functions of forests to be safeguarded (EU Forest Strategy)

..Innovation in mobilising different types of forest biomass for all potential markets and better interlink supply/demand.

Where/how to increase?

- Only 60 70% of the annual increment of EU forests is harvested
- Major potential: small private holdings + silvicultural practices (pruning, thinnings...)
