- 1. WHAT WE HAVE TO DO FOR EACH FG? Establishing a possible programme with participants after the final report:
- A reflection on the results achieved is necessary to "clear up the conclusions", adjust them to the PT needs and identify next steps.
- The information targets
- Adapt message to targets
- Which instruments for each stakeholders group? (seminars; translation; documents; visits; ...)
- To involve certain stakeholders (education and training, policy makers, national authorities, ...
